Upcoming Union Presidential Election Absentee Voting Begins January 28, 2010

The election for Union President is about to begin and in accordance with the Union's By-Laws the Executive Committee has set the following time lines:

- January 27th close of business: Presidential Candidate letters must be submitted to the Union office.
- January 28th: **Absentee voting begins at the CSP Union** between the hours of 0830 and 1630 Monday through Friday, except on State recognized holidays. Any member is eligible to vote by absentee ballot, in person at the Union office and upon presenting identification, in the event they will be away and unable to vote by mail.
- First week of February: Ballots and campaign material mailed out to membership.
- February 24th: Balloting closes at the end of the business day (1630 hours). All ballots must be received at the Union office, either mailed or hand delivered, no later than the close of business in order to be counted.
- February 25th: Ballots will be counted at the Union office beginning at 0900 hours.
- Members on military deployment will receive their ballot at their home address of record and may instruct a family member or other designated person to cast the vote on their behalf.
